



Dear Friends,

Please remember there are two Fast Days in Lent: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days alone, those of us who are eighteen years of age and have not reached our fifty-ninth birthday are asked not to eat meat and to eat only one full meal. The two other meals of the day are to be less than the 'full meal' to maintain strength according to one's needs.

In the dioceses of the United States, the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence to be observed by everyone over fourteen years of age. These days of abstinence are to be meat free. For those of us who do not eat meat, it is down to one basic principle: keep it simple. It hardly makes sense not to eat meat on the Fridays of Lent and then to have a lobster tail, two-dozen shrimp, or you name it. Keep in mind that we are asked to fast and abstain during Lent, not diet. The money we would save or the food we would not use (meat, candy, alcohol, etc.) should be given to the poor possibly through the many charitable organizations who are constantly looking for our help. Thus, we fulfill the obligation to become more charitable and merciful.

Next Friday, February 26, the Sunday 11:15 am Children's Liturgy of the Word Group will present the Stations of the Cross at 7:00 pm and offer a simple supper afterwards at 7:30 pm. The donations will be given to a local charity, Mission of Yahweh.

Now, I have a prayer request for you; something you might like to discern over the period of Lent. Please prayerfully consider giving a commitment of two years to being a member of St. Catherine's to-be-newly-formed Parish Council. I have been reading about all sorts of ways of doing this, and the simplest and fairest way I have come across is to ask people who are at least eighteen years of age and registered members of the parish to put his/her name in a basket. No one will be nominating or putting a name forward; only you will do this. I am proposing that seven names would be drawn out of a basket the Sunday following Easter Sunday. The purpose of the Parish Council is to counsel/advise the pastor regarding the future direction of the parish. No one will represent any group, council, or committee - it is the future of the parish as a whole that we would be considering. Let us discern new ways of allowing the Spirit of God to work in and through us. The archdiocese will give us the necessary training and guidance to

get us started. I would envisage us meeting on average eight times a year. Thus, keeping as close as possible to the school calendar and taking a well-deserved break during non-school time. There is a lot to pray about here, and I will talk about this at mass during Lent. I am always available to field any questions you may have after mass any weekend should you feel so inclined.
